



Utility Fee Explanation

You are billed for sewage based on the amount of water you use. All water ends up being sewage except for the small amount you use to cook and drink. Anything that goes down the drain (toilet, sink, bathtub and washer) is sewage. This charge is usually quite a bit higher than the water bill because it goes to the city that handles your water to pay for sanitary sewer systems and sewage treatment plants so that the sewage can be processed and the water cleaned so it can be used again and not dumped into the landscape.
